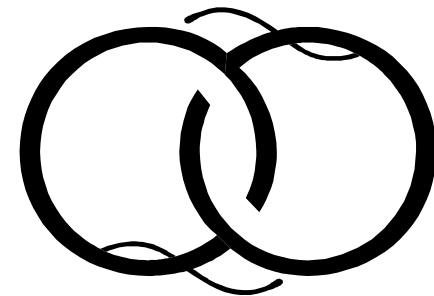
## For marriage outside Mass(NO communion)
